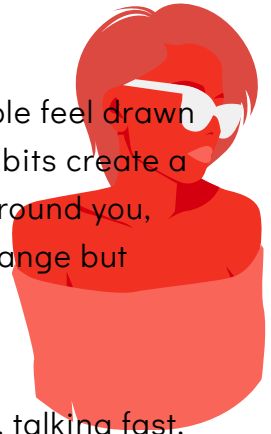


Seven Weird Habits That Make People Suddenly Attracted to You
