- Effective Teaching is the knowledge, strategies, process & behaviors that lead to good student outcomes.

Effective Teaching Behavior

- 2 types of behaviors that lead to effective teaching

- ① Key Behavior
- ② Helping Behavior

I Key Behavior (LITES)

- ① Lesson clarity → uncomplicated, step by step order.
- ② Instructional variety → technology, materials, activities etc use of variation in voice & gestures.
- ③ Teacher Task orientation → To maximize time spent in teaching. Prevent distracting behavior.
- ④ Engagement in the learning process → Keep daily schedule to minimize confusion among students & give independent work that is interesting.
- ⑤ Student success rate → For a better success rate, the content should reflect prior learning, with easy to grasp steps for the new material.

II 5 Helpful Behaviors

- ① using student ideas & contributions - Teachers should acknowledge student responses.
- ② Structuring → Teachers should give organized lesson of what is to come & summarize what has been taught.
- ③ Questioning → use a variety of questions that require more thinking & problem solving.
- ④ Probing (वित्तु चरत) → Getting students to elaborate on their imp. ideas.
- ⑤ Teacher affects → Develop the teacher learner relationship by the use of enthusiasm & empathy.
